BACKPACKS FOR HUNGRY CHILDREN

All of us are concerned about the kids who receive food from our back packs and how will they fare this summer when there is not school breakfast or lunch. Joseph Keels Elementary School has enough funding for one month of Summer school. Therefore at the present time we will pack 35 back packs per week for the month of **June only**. Since the school will operate only Monday through Thursday we will need to adjust backpack quantities for the extra day and gather together the snacks on **Wednesdays** for delivery on Thursdays. **We are in need of milk, cereal, and meal items OTHER than Vienna sausage (tuna salad packets, chicken salad packets, etc.)**

Starting in June, the back-packs will go home on Thursdays with the kids in summer school. In July, Mrs. Ladue the Principal of Keels, has agreed that they will allow any student who wants to, to come by and pick up food on Thursdays. The devotion and concern that you have shown for our families made the need clear to them. When they realized how many kids in the district were getting additional food through back-pack programs, they wanted to make sure those kids had some type of safety net.
